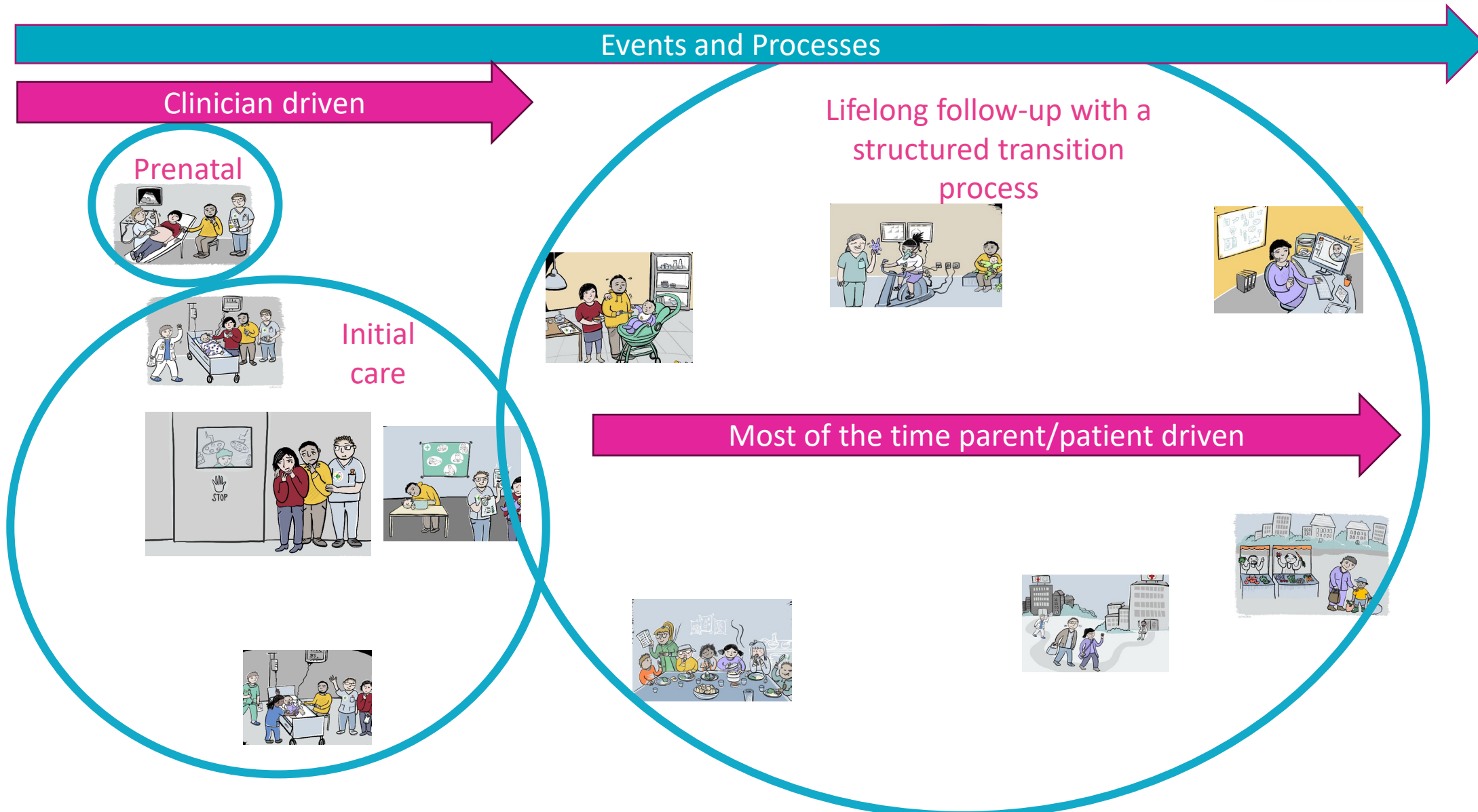
## Patient and One of the oldest survivor
